



The Pentagram has always had very mysterious powers ascribed to it. In the Middle Ages it was looked upon as a talisman of immense power, and was worn for health and safety, both in the spiritual as well as in the physical sense.

Peter Deunov said about the Pentagram: "You should study often this picture and meditate on its symbols. The words written around the Pentagram are very important to you. - 'In the accomplishment of God's will is the strength of the human soul.' If you use the Pentagram, you shall work for the Glory of God. If you use it correctly, it will become a source of prosperity and blessings for you."

Peter Deunov recommended using it to develop a quality you're lacking by placing the Pentagram horizontally and pointing the corresponding angle toward the heart. The energy flows through this virtue into you as you recite the appropriate prayer for the virtue three times: For example, if you desire more wisdom, point the arm of the Pentagram that has the all-seeing eye toward your heart and recite three times: "In the accomplishment of God's will through Wisdom is the strength of human soul"

When in danger and you don't have the Pentagram handy, you can visualize the Pentagram with your right hand holding Justice (Christ) and your left hand holding Truth (stairway). Then, with the all-seeing eye of Wisdom pointing towards the threatening object, you recite: "In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, I ask God, the Great and Mighty One, to do what is good in His eyes." Any place where the Pentagram is placed is protected; it's strong vibrations guard against evil influences and dark entities that cannot even approach nearby.

The Pentagram is properly arranged when it is placed with it's apex at the top. It is absolutely forbidden to turn the Pentagram upside down or to use it for selfish purposes, such as getting money, power, love, or revenge. This is black magic. You can accrue great karmic debts and suffer a backlash from the energies of the Pentagram if you use it for these purposes. Also, if any negative words or emotions are expressed in the room where the Pentagram is placed, they will have a destructive effect because the Pentagram emanates positive force and the mixture of these two forces will result in disaster. It should be put in a glass frame, and placed on your altar or in a special quiet room, rarely used by people, in which you usually pray. The power of the Pentagram should not be taken lightly. Peter Deunov advised his disciples against wearing it unconsciously like a scapula talisman. You can use it consciously along with certain short prayers such as the ones for protection in danger or for developing virtues.

Peter Deunov also said that when you are in a situation of necessity you can "Picture a Pentagram around you at first mentally, then by hand, and finally use the three prayers: 'In the fulfillment of the Will of God lies the power of the human soul,' 'For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life,' and 'But seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be added to you.'" While saying these prayers, visualize them superimposed over the picture of the Pentagram. The first around the outer circle, the second around the pentagram itself, and the third in the center of the Pentagram. Each of these prayers correspond with a plume of your threefold flame: the first is God power or will, the second is God love, and the third is God Wisdom or wise dominion.
