Purpose of Course:

The purpose of this course is to explore the relationship between the master Kuan Yin, the virtue kindness and the subject of kin domain and how they connect with each other.

Course Outline

- Kuan Yin
 - Learn the meaning of Kuan Yin's name as "Hearer of the World's Sounds."
 - Practice Kuan Yin's method for listening which the Shurangama Sutra describes as her method for attaining enlightenment.
 - Study some sacred symbols of Kuan Yin's manifestations, objects and postures.
 - Listen to an excerpt of a newly composed symphony to the Goddess of Mercy.

- Kindness
 - Explore teachings about the virtues of kindness by ascended masters, including Kuan Yin.
 - Hear sharing about what kindness means to students and how it been shown in their lives and in the lives of others.
 - Learn about the School of Kindness whose mission is to spread kindness throughout the world.

- Kin Domain
 - Explore Russian mystic Anastasia's concept of kin domain and how many of these family Paradise Gardens have already been created.
 - Discuss the meaning "kin" and talk about for whom we are preparing our legacy using Kuan Yin's advice for blessing our kin.
 - View pictures of a kin domain garden paradise in the small alpine town of Mount Shasta, California.
 - Hear students share stories about their gardens!
